

Trap Neuter Return Guidelines and Rules

- 1. Please do not come to a TNR without a confirmed reservation.
- 2. Registration is between 7:15 am. and 7:45 am. No cats will be accepted after 8:00am on a TNR surgery morning.
- 3. Please do not bring in more cats then you are pre-registered for.
- 4. If you trap fewer cats than you are registered for, bring what you were able to trap.
- 5. Cats must be at least 5 months old.
- 6. Do not bring in females that are still nursing kittens. We will not sterilize them. They will be sent back to their nursing babies.
- 7. If you are on the schedule and are unable to trap any of the cats please contact 793-2490 and leave a message. You will need to call the Angels Among Us number to get back on the TNR schedule.
- 8. Each cat will be sent home in a carrier (if available). If you bring in cats in live traps and have any available carriers at home, please bring them with you. If you have more than 1 cat in a carrier, please bring in a carrier for each additional cat.
- 9. TNR is for feral and free roaming community cats, please do not bring in your own "pets". This is a violation of any funding we receive to help continue the program at no charge to residents of Saginaw County.
- 10. Make sure you are available to pick up after surgery. The pick-up time can be as early as 2:00 pm.
- 11.If you are found to be in violation of these instructions, you risk losing access to future TNR Clinics.
